Collaborative projects in the second pillar of Horizon Europe are mostly transnational projects for which you need to find partners.

Where and how to find partners?

There are several ways to find partners to complete or join a Horizon Europe consortium.

Funding & Tender Portal of the European Commission



The [F&T Portal Partner Search tool](#) offers the possibility to find partners and to post offers directly in the same portal used for accessing the topics of the calls of projects. The system is not supervised, which means that there is no quality control done on the content.



Enterprise Europe Network Partner Search Tool

The Enterprise Europe Network (EEN) manages Europe's largest [online database of worldwide](#) business opportunities. It contains thousands of business, technology requests and offers from companies, as well as research cooperation requests (partner searches). The database is accessible for free. With the help of [Enterprise Europe Brussels advisors](#), a company profile with the description of activities and cooperation offer/request can be set up to find cooperation partners. It is also possible to subscribe to receive alerts on new requests and offers. One advantage of the database is the quality control and intermediation by your local EEN advisor. NCP Brussels works closely with Enterprise Europe Brussels; most of the NCPs are also EEN advisors and can provide guidance on the use of the EEN partner search tools and inform about the latest [brokerage events](#) and other matchmaking opportunities. These events will be organised in cooperation with NCPs and the support of the EEN, usually back to back with Info Days hosted by the European Commission.



NCP Brussels is strongly embedded in several transnational networks of National Contact Points which may provide partner search tools in the future or at least a channel for your NCP to support your search. You can contact your National Contact Point(s) about this, to benefit also from the other services they would offer, such as, invitations to brokerage events, training sessions, periodic newsletters, relevant tools and so on.

How to proceed?

If you are looking for partners or a consortium, [contact your NCP](#) on how to best proceed. In order to facilitate the search, your NCP will ask you to fill in a **partner search template** which is available upon request.
