


# THE HORIZON RESULT PLATFORM

The Horizon Result Platform aims at better disseminating « key exploitable results » from Horizon 2020 and Horizon Europe projects. It can be useful both for Horizon Europe/Horizon 2020 beneficiaries, for applicants and for other actors.



Horizon Result Platform (HRP) was launched in September 2019 to facilitate and promote the uptake of EU funded Horizon 2020 R&I key exploitable results. Now embedded in the legal basis of the EU Research and Innovation funding programme for 2021-2027, Horizon Europe, the HRP offers EU R&I funding beneficiaries a new, easy to use and free advertising and matchmaking tool. A TV channel provided some explanatory videos.









### For Horizon Europe/Horizon 2020 beneficiaries

Your work does not stop at the end of your Horizon 2020/Horizon Europe project. You have an obligation to continue to exploit and disseminate your project results up to four years after the end of the project as stipulated in articles 28 and 29 of the Horizon 2020 Model Grant Agreement.

In particular, if you have Key Exploitable Results (KERs) of any nature such as products, services, software, policy recommendations, you are strongly encouraged under Horizon 2020 to publish those on the Horizon Results Platform. This is done not only to fulfil their dissemination and exploitation obligations but also to find and attract new partners, investors or other types of support needed in valorising the R&I results. More information in the guidance note How to make full use of the results of your project.

You should not use this platform as another website to communicate or report on the results of your project, but really as support service that can help you connect with all the stakeholders that can bring your project to later stage of development. The user guide provides a definition and criteria to select and prioritise your results as well as explanation on how to publish it. The entry should be written having in mind the information the target would need to help you further.

Especially, SMEs beneficiaries of EU-funded programmes can benefit from support from the Enterprise Europe Network to turn their research results into business opportunities. If rightly filled, the HRP can help EEN better spot such SMEs. Otherwise do not hesitate to contact Enterprise Europe Brussels directly.

#### For Horizon Europe applicants

The HRP can also be useful for applicants for proposal writing and partner search. Indeed, Horizon Europe project are supposed to build on and go further past projects which represent the "state of the art". Therefore you can consult the HRP to find out relevant past results that could be further developed in your project and through the HRP you can contact the result owner as a potential partner for your project. You should use various filters to refine your search, such as the filter "looking for collaboration".

#### For other actors

In addition, the platform offers investors, companies and other industrial operators new business and partnering opportunities as well as access to novel R&I based solutions. Many filters are available to find the right results for your profile according to what the result owner is looking for: business partners, collaboration, sharing knowledge, investors.... The result description further explained the result owners' needs, maturity, scalability, sustainability and unique value proposition. The Investors' corner include some useful materials for investors.
